KAUPAPA/*TOPICS* (Tīpakohia TĒTAHI/*Choose ONE*)

1. Tangata ākona ki te kāinga, tūnga ki te marae tau ana

He hua tō te ako i te kāinga otirā, i ngā wā o mua koirā te mahi kia tau ai te tū ki te marae. I tērā tau i te rāhui whakamohoao i noho ā-whare ngā tauira o Aotearoa ki te mahi i ngā mahi o te kura. E ai ki ētahi:

- ko te ako ā-matihiko i te kāinga, he rautaki pai mō ngā rā kei te heke mai
- me ako tonu ngā tauira ki te kāinga, ki ngā marae, ki waenganui i tōna iwi. He aha ōu whakaaro ki te ako i te kāinga, ā, he aha koe i whakaaro pērā ai? (Ka whakaae, ka whakahē rānei. Whakawhānuitia ōu whakaaro.)

Learning at home can come with many benefits. In the past, a child well-taught at home was a credit to their people. Last year during the lockdown all students from around New Zealand worked from the comfort of their own homes to complete their work for school. Some people feel that:

- online learning from home is a strategy we should continue
- students should still be learning at home, on the marae, and amongst their own people. What are your thoughts about learning at home and why? (You can agree or disagree, provided you explain in detail.)

2. Utua!

4. Tō rautaki reo Māori
