1. He pūrākau, he pakiwaitara

Tuhia he pūrākau, he pakiwaitara rānei. Me whai tō tuinga i ētahi whanonga pono hei whakaawe i te kaipānui. Hei tauira: te māiatanga, te whai whakaarotanga, te manawa rekatanga, te atawhaitanga, te pukumahitanga, te rangatiratanga, te aha atu rānei.

A mythical story

Write a mythical story or narrative. Your story should contain values to inspire the reader – for example, bravery, wisdom, curiosity, kindness, hard work, leadership, etc.

2. Ko taku rautaki hei whakatika i tētahi take taiao

4. Te panonitanga o ngā tikanga

Ka panoni ētahi o ngā tikanga i runga i ngā āhuatanga o te wā, ehara i te mea ka noho kau te katoa. He aha tētahi, ētahi tikanga rānei kua panoni i ngā tau kua hipa, ā, ki tō whakaaro me pēhea e panoni ai kia hāngai ki te āhua o te ao i roto i ngā tau kei te heke mai.

Tuhia he kōrero mō te/ngā tikanga kua whiriwhiria e koe. Hei taura: pōwhiri, hongī, tangihanga, karanga, whaikōrero, karakia, kohi kaimoana, te aha atu rānei.

5. Kī-o-rahi

I te wā o Te Pakanga Tuarua o Te Ao i haere Te Hokowhitu a Tū ki Ūropi. Ka mutu ka haria, ka tākarohia hoki tētahi kēmu Māori i taua wā ki aua whenua. Ko te kī-o-rahi taua kēmu. Kātahi te tōmina a te hunga nō Wīwī nō Itāria hoki ki tēnei kēmu. Ka akohia katoatia te kēmu, te pūrākau me ngā tikanga tuku iho e pā ana ki te taonga tākaro nei. Kua waru tekau tau te kī-o-rahi e tākaro tonu ana.

Tuhia he rautaki whakarauora kia horapa haere te kī-o-rahi i te motu.

Kī-o-rahi

The 28th Māori Battalion fought in Europe in the Second World War. While there, they played the Māori game kī-o-rahi. French and Italian soldiers and citizens learnt how to play the game and about its history and etiquette. Kī-o-rahi is still played in Europe nearly 80 years later.
