# QUESTION ONE: Paloveape faka-Tonga (A Tongan proverb)

Read Text A on page 2 of the resource booklet and use it to respond to the following questions.

- (a) Ko e hā 'a e pōto'i ngāue na'e ma'u 'e he kau Lēmaki 'o Ha'ano'? Fakamatala'i fakaikiiki mai pea 'omai mo ha fakatātā mei' he talanoa' ke ne poupou'i ho'o tali'. What skills did the Lemaki people of Ha'ano possess? Explain using evidence from the text to support your answer.
- (b) Ko e hā 'a e felāve'i 'a e kakai Tonga' mo e ngaahi fonua kaunga'api 'o e Pasifiki' fakatatau ki he lau 'a e talanoa'?
  According to the text, what is the relationship between Tange and the other Desific islands?

According to the text, what is the relationship between Tonga and the other Pacific islands?

(c) Ko e hā e 'uhinga 'o e palōveape ko 'ení "tefua 'a vaka lautala" pea ko e ma'u mei fe´, 'o fakatatau ki he lau 'a e talanoa´?

What is the meaning of the proverb "tefua 'a vaka lautala" as described in the text, and how did it come about?

## QUESTION TWO: Fakamatala mei' he nusipepá (Newspaper article)

Read Text B on page 3 of the resource booklet and use it to respond to the following questions.

Who is 'Elevina Batick and what happened to her? Explain your answer in detail.

(b) Ko e hā 'a e ngaahi faingata'a na'e fetaulaki mo 'Elevina 'i Hawkes Bay? Fakamatala'i pea 'omai mo ha fakatātā mei' he talanoa' ke ne poupou'i ho'o tali'.
 What challenges did 'Elevina face in Hawke's Bay? Explain using evidence from the text to support your answer.
