FIRST PASSAGE – SECTION 1

READER 5 ‘E fakaava ‘i Tonga ‘a e ‘uluaki Laipeli ki he komiunití, ko e ola ia e ngāue fakataha ‘a ha kakai mei Nu'u Sila mo Tonga, pea ko e fakatātā totonu eni ‘etau lea Tonga: “Tākanga ‘etau fohé”. Na'e kamata e fakakaukaú ni ‘e he ongo mātu'a mei Saute 'Okalani, lolotonga 'ena foaki ha ngaahi koloa ki hona kolo ko Kolovaí koe'ahi ko 'enau fakaakeake mei he afā Saikolone ko Kitá.

Na'e fakaofo 'a e poupoú he ko e Laipeli 'e nima ua 'i 'Okalani na'a nau me'a'ofa 'aki e ngaahi tohi 'e lauiafe. Ko e Sky Televisioné ne nau foaki e ngaahi lepitopu 'e tolu noa. Ko e kautaha pasikala ko e ONZO ne nau me'a'ofa mai 'aki e pasikala 'e ua fā. Ko e Falekoloa Pāningí ne nau foaki mai e ngaahi kapa vali. Pea pehē foki ki hono fakafolau ta'etotongi ki Tonga e ngaahi koloá ni 'e he Kautaha Vaka CFR.

SECOND PASSAGE – SECTION 1

READER 2 Ko Meleané ko e Tonga pea ‘oku fai fatongia ‘i he tafa’aki ‘o e mo’ui lelei. ‘Oku fehokotaki vāofi mo e ngaahi famili Tongá he ‘okú ne ngāue ‘aki pē ‘enau leá ke fakamahino ki he loto ‘o e Tongá ‘a e mahu’inga ‘enau fili ki he me’atokoní ‘e kau ki he ‘enau mo’ui lelei.

Ka ‘oku hangē ‘a e talanoa ia kiaí ko e tau ‘a ha “ki’i komiunití vaivai mo masiva mo e ngaahi fu’u pisinisi lalahi mo tu’umalie”. He ‘oku lahi ‘a e ngaahi Pisinisi falekai me’akai ‘ave vave, ‘oku nau fili ‘a e feitu’u ke tu’u ai ‘enau pisinisí. Ka ‘oku ‘ikai ha le’o ia e komiunití ke nau talaatu pe ‘oku nau loto ki ai pē ‘ikai. Ko e fakaloloma tahá, he ko kinautolu ‘oku lavea ngofuá. ‘Oku ‘a’au ‘e he ngaahi pisinisi me’akai ‘ave vave si’enau seniti ‘oku nau ngāue mate ke ma’ú. Pea ‘oku ‘efihia hení e kakaí, he masivá mo e tukuhausiá, pea ‘ikai ha’anau toe fili, ka ko e afe atu pē ‘o fakatau e ngaahi me’atokoni vavé, he ‘oku ma’ama’a, ifo pea ‘osi maau foki ke kai, neongo ‘a ‘enau ‘ilo ‘oku fonu he ngakó, māsimá mo e suká peá nau fakatupu foki e ngaahi palopalema lahi ki he mo’ui.

SECOND PASSAGE – SECTION 2

Ko e fānau Pasifiki ta’u 2–14, ‘oku nau fu’u sisino. ‘I he to’u ko’ení, ko e peseti ‘e 25 ‘o e fānau Pasifikí ‘oku nau fu’u sisino ‘i hono fakahoa ki he peseti pē ‘e 10 ‘o e fakakatoa ‘o e fanau ‘i he ta’u 2–14 ‘i Nu’u Silá ni. Ko e faka’amú, ke ta’ota’ofi ‘a e sisinó ke ‘oua e hoko atu ki he’enau lalahí, he te ne fakatupu ‘a e mahaki mafú, toto ma’olungá, suká, mo e pā kālavá.

‘Oku ‘i ai e ui kole tokoni meia Meleane mo e kau taki e ngaahi Komiunití Tongá mo e Pasifikí, ke fai ha liliu fakavavevave ki he ngaahi lao ‘o e pisinisi falekai vavé, he ‘oku nau tu’u ofi ki he ngaahi ‘api ‘o e kakai ‘oku nau lavea ngofua ki he me’á ni. Pea ‘oku uesia lahi ai ‘enau ma’u’anga pa’angá pea pehē ki he mo’ui lelei ‘a e fānaú. Pea ‘e tokoni eni ki hotau ngaahi falemahakí foki, he ‘oku tokosi’i e kau ngāue ke tokanga’i e kau mahakí.

- READER 3** Mālō ‘etau lava ki he ‘ahó ni kāinga fanongo. ‘Oku ou ‘i hení mo e faiako ‘univēsití, ko e Kiwi-Tonga, kuó ne foki mai ke ne hoko ko e faiako he ‘Apiako Akitekí mo e Palani ‘a e ‘Univesiti ‘o ‘Okalaní. Ko e hā e me‘a na‘á ne tauhele‘i koe ke ke foki mai aí?
- READER 4** Ko hoku kāingá ko ‘enau omi mei Tonga, Ha‘amoa, Uvea pea mo Fisi. Ko ‘eku fehokotaki mo e Pasifikí, na‘á ne fakalotolahi‘i au keu foki mai ki Aotearoá. Fakataha mo iá, ke ‘i ai ha faingamālie ki he‘eku fānaú ke nau tupu hake hení mo nau vāofi mo ‘eku ongo mātu‘á ‘i Otara, he na‘e pehē pē ‘emau tupu hake mo e fānau ‘e toko valu.
- READER 3** ‘I he kolísí, ko e hā e me‘a na‘á ne faka‘ai‘ai koe ke ke manako he ‘akitekí?

- READER 4** Na‘e ‘a‘ahi ange ‘a e tangata ‘akiteki ki ‘apiako he uike ne tu‘uaki ai e ngaahi ngāue kehekehe, pea u sai‘ia he‘ene vahevahé. Na‘á ku ‘alu foki he ‘a‘ahi ‘emau kalasí ki he ngaahi feitu‘u faka-hisitōlia motu‘a ‘i ‘Itali, Kalisi pea mo Falanissé, pea u fakapapau‘i aipe ‘eku filí.

THIRD PASSAGE – SECTION 2

- READER 3** ‘Oku ‘i ai ha taha ‘oku nima mea‘a ho fāmilí ‘o hangē ko koé?
- READER 4** Na‘e ma‘u pale ‘eku tangata‘eikí ‘i hono talēniti tā fakatātā ‘i Tonga. Ko hoku mehikitangá ‘okú ne ngaohi e koloa faka-Tonga hangē ko e fala mo e ngatu. Ko ‘eku fine‘eikí ko hono faiva e tui kahoa pelesitikí, ngaohi kafu mo e pilo. Ko e ni‘ihi hoku fanga tuonga‘ané ‘oku nau taleniti hiva. ‘I he pisinisi ta‘o keké, ‘oku ‘i ai hoku ta‘okete ko hono talēniti ia. He ‘ikai ngalo ‘emau tupu haké mo e nofo tokolahí pea fakalata e talanoá mo e vahevahe e ngaahi fakakaukau fo‘oú.
- READER 3** ‘E anga fēfē ha‘o fakalotolahi‘i e fānau Tongá mo e Pasifikí ki he mala‘e ‘o e Akiteki?
- READER 4** Ko ‘ete vahevahe ‘a e anga ‘ete fononga mai he akó pē mo‘u! Talanoa‘i ‘a e ngaahi lavame‘a ‘a kinautolu he ‘akiteki pē ha toe taleniti kehe pē he akó, pē siasí, pe ngaahi kulupu to‘utupú, pea mo e faiongoongó. Peá ke fakalotolahi‘i foki e fānaú ke fili e ngaahi lesoni totonu ki he ngaahi mala‘e pē ngāue ‘oku nau fakataumu‘a ki ai ‘enau akó pē ngāué he kaha‘ú.
