5. Analyse how a turning point enhanced your understanding of one or more ideas.  
*“Ideas” may refer to character, theme, or setting.*
6. Analyse how language features helped you read beyond the lines of the text.
7. Analyse how ideas in the text helped you see the world with fresh eyes.  
*“Ideas” may refer to character, theme, or setting.*
8. Analyse how the author’s purpose was revealed through a character’s actions.
