





Tīvaevae Kūki ‘Airani
‘Iri‘iri kāpua nā te aronga ‘akamata tui tīvaevae

‘E reka ana koe ‘i te tuitui? ‘E ‘akakoro‘anga tēta‘i kā tupu a tēia au rā ki mua? Ka ‘inangaro koe ‘i te ‘ōronga ‘i tēta‘i ‘apinga aro‘a pu‘apinga nō tēia? Ka ‘inangaro koe i te ‘anga ‘i tēta‘i ‘apinga ‘akama‘ara‘anga, tē kā riro ‘ei tāporoporo ‘i tō‘ou tua, mē kore, ‘i tēta‘i ‘apinga ‘akaperepere ta‘ito nā tō‘ou kōpū tangata, tē ka ‘ōronga‘ia ki te au uki o mua?

Piri mai ‘i rotopū ia mātou nō tētai varu ‘epetoma, ia mātou ka ‘akamata ei ‘i te ma‘ani tīvaevae. ‘E au tīvaevae tuitui rima tēia, ‘e mea pu‘apinga ki te ‘iti tangata Kūki ‘Airani. Kā ō katoa atu koe ki roto ‘i te pupu ‘akaoraora ‘ē te tāporoporo ‘i te ‘ākono‘anga tui tīvaevae Kūki ‘Airani.

‘I te tuātau ‘iri‘iri kāpua, ka torō ‘ē ka pākoti koe ‘i tā‘au vāito, ka tāpiripiri ‘i tā‘au vāito ki runga ‘i te auaro tīvaevae, ‘ē ka ‘āpi‘i‘ia koe ‘i te au tui tūkēkē.

‘Auraka e manamanatā mē ko koe anake ‘ua ka ‘aere mai ei. Ko te aronga ka tae mai, ‘āiteite tō kōtou tumu ka ‘aere mai ei. Nō tē tuitui rima ‘ia ana te tīvaevae, ka riro tēia ‘ei tuātau ‘piri‘anga, ‘ē te tā‘okota‘i. Ko te parāni‘anga ‘i te vāito tīvaevae, kā ‘akakite mai tē reira ‘i tetā‘i tua, tē kā vai ‘ua atu rāi. ‘E tuku taime katoa ana mātou, nō te ‘ātui atu ki te kātoatoa tei tae mai. Iā koe ‘ē rave ra i tā‘au ‘anga‘anga, ka ‘akarongo koe, ka ‘o‘ora i tō‘ou manako, ka tāmou, tua ‘i tō‘ou tua, ka tuatua, kā kata. ‘E ‘ākono‘anga tēia ka ‘akama‘ata atu ‘i tō‘ou kite ‘i te karape tei anoano‘ia.

Mē kite koe ‘i te tui tīvaevae, ‘auraka e karapi‘i! ‘Āpi‘i‘ia atu tēia au kite karape, ‘ē te tāporoporo ki tēta‘i kē.
