

  Discuss the impact of a specific place on the conception, production, and interpretation of your chosen work.
- **3.** Taonga is defined as "treasure, anything prized applied to anything considered to be of value including socially or culturally valuable objects, resources, phenomenon, ideas, and techniques" (Te Aka Māori Dictionary).
  - Discuss how this concept of taonga applies to the conception, production, and interpretation of your chosen work.
- **4.** Music is deeply connected to the historical era in which it was written. In fact, it cannot be separated from it.
  - Discuss this statement in relation to the conception, production, and interpretation of your chosen work.
