Q	Grade score	Annotation			
1	M6	Candidate demonstrates clear understanding of the skills Jackie Chan practised and how he improved these skills, but does not convey meaning for how Jackie Chan became an international star, hence doesn't demonstrate thorough understanding.			
2	M6	Clearly identifies directions to the Great Wall, however the cost was not provided. Suggestions from Tiantian are mostly identified and would score E7 if further meaning was conveyed, such as: a) why Tiantian suggested the restaurant b) what food Sam should bring, and c) buying things in Beijing instead of the Great Wall.			
3	M6	Clearly identifies the features of the school in Shanghai. Demonstrates Katie's general feelings toward English and maths and would score higher if they identified that her English teacher gets her to speak English with classmates, and also conveyed why Katie's feelings are mixed.			
4	M6	Clearly identifies what Li Xing's parents do for Katie but does not demonstrate thorough understanding. For example, when does Katie stay in their house? How did Katie feel about the restaurant? Why does Katie not like boiled water?
