1	6	The candidate provides one detailed point explaining why the moko wants to be a kuia on the marae and includes a relevant reference to the text. The response does not provide enough analysis to achieve at a higher level.			
2	5	Although the candidate is undecided if they think that humour is a good way to build relationships, they have provided one detailed point of their thoughts and reasons with relevant reference to the text. The response does not provide enough description to achieve at a higher level.			
3	5	The candidate provides a relevant occupation for the father and includes a relevant reference to the text to justify their answer. They do not provide enough detail to achieve at a higher level.			
4	5	The candidate agrees that the ocean has a language and provides one detailed response with relevant reference to the text. They do not answer enough aspects of the question to achieve at a higher level.
