	<p>This candidate has produced an informative description of a 'rā whakawhanaungatanga' that their kapa haka group is holding. The candidate begins to use the planning page, and the report flows in a logical manner because of this. The topics written about are appropriate to the task and also the genre of the writing task.</p> <p>A range of grammatical constructions and linking phrases have been used. However, there are a number of simple mistakes that could have been avoided at this level. The candidate begins to incorporate their own opinion and attempts more detailed explanation of different activities. Writing conventions are adequately followed and the response is broken up into paragraphs.</p> <p>Overall grade is Merit (High). The candidate has demonstrated clarity in their writing, which is clearly planned and structured. The lack of detail in places to extend beyond the basic information presented and limited range of grammatical structures with a number of simple errors has prevented the candidate from achieving higher.</p>
