### QUESTION ONE

If you were An An, which of the three itineraries would you recommend to Hemi? Explain why, using evidence from the entire text to support your answer.

I think coming back on the 26<sup>th</sup> would be a better idea because for him to go travelling again he would need to most probably repack his suitcase again and will ~~it~~ should be given time to rest before heading off in another flight. Hemi states that he wants to stay in Shanghai a little bit longer compared to Beijing. In the first itinerary ~~he only stays in~~ Hemi stay in Beijing for ~~4~~ ten days and 8 days in Shanghai. ~~But~~ In the second ~~he~~ stays in Beijing for 10 days and Shanghai for 12 days. If Hemi ~~really is~~ really wanted to stay in Shanghai longer he ~~would~~ should most likely choose the second itinerary because on the third one ~~he~~ Hemi does not return before the new year but nor does he stay in Shanghai longer than Beijing. Whereas in the ~~second~~ first itinerary he comes back before the new year but stays in Beijing longer than Shanghai. The second itinerary is the one I would recommend to Hemi because it meets both 'criteria's' of returning before the new year and staying in Shanghai a little bit longer. Although he may have to leave once again as soon as he comes back from China, it may be better to do that so he will experience less time difference problems. //

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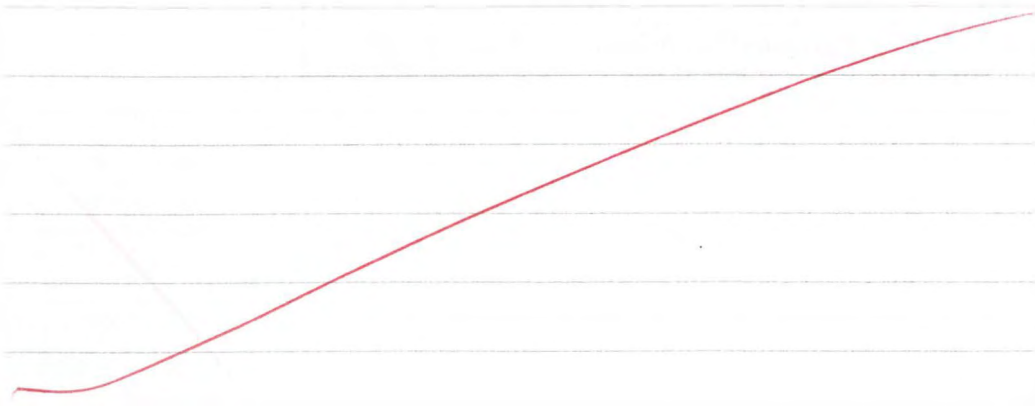

1	A4	Although the candidate has selected an incorrect itinerary for this answer, they demonstrate some understanding of the text and convey the general meaning. The information is largely correct; for example, they are able to identify the preferred date to return and that Hemi wants to stay in Shanghai longer than Beijing, with some comparison with the other two itineraries. However, not all relevant information in the text is used to answer the question.			
2	A4	The candidate has selected some information to explain their answer, with an opinion, such as the quality of the air and stores' opening time. However, not enough information is given to demonstrate clear understanding of the <i>whole</i> text, although opinion and justification are given.			
3	A4	The candidate mentions NZ movies, art and music, and China's creativity, such as written character language and clothing. This basic information is required for Achieved.
