QUESTION THREE

1	A4	<p>The candidate demonstrated understanding of the text and conveys some general meaning by outlining how Lanlan’s bus came late, how she couldn’t find her classroom, and how she couldn’t understand the teacher. In part (b), the candidate’s response included basic information such as interesting Chinese class, made friends, played Quizlet, and played football together.</p> <p>For M5, the candidate needed to either explain responses to part (b) in more detail and accuracy, or include other information, such as how much the food costed, and how the students’ Chinese “weren’t bad”.</p>				
2	A3	<p>The candidate demonstrated some understanding of the text and conveys some general meaning by identifying a few basic facts about the two restaurants and making a conclusion in part (c) based on some accurate information. The candidate understood the Phoenix has delicious food and Golden House is a Chinese restaurant cheaper than Phoenix. They also explained briefly that Lanlan would be accustomed to the Chinese food at Golden House, although it was not clearly explained why.</p> <p>For A4, the candidate needed to identify the beach next to Phoenix and the mountain next to Golden House, because these were key pieces of information to be referenced to support the conclusion.</p>				
3	A3	<p>The candidate demonstrated some understanding of the text and conveys some general meaning by identifying the time the match began, the public transport available, the weather and the bad food. The price of the food and drink and how they got to the sports stadium were not identified, which was key information for good general understanding and supporting evidence for inferencing in part (b).</p> <p>For A4, candidate needed to include the aforementioned information.</p>
