1	E7	<p>The candidate demonstrated thorough understanding and communicated the implied meanings of the text by clearly explaining all relevant information regarding Lanlan’s problems and how her day took a positive turn after she arrived at Chinese class.</p> <p>For E8, the candidate needed to show evidence of understanding some details, such as when Lanlan intended to catch the bus, when school started, and what time she eventually arrived school.</p>				
2	E7	<p>The candidate demonstrated thorough understanding and communicated the implied meanings of the text by using evidence from the text to clearly justify their inferencing. Although some relevant information was not included in part (a) and (b) of Question Two, these details were written in part (c), where there was also evidence of elaboration. The candidate made key inferences, such as how Lanlan should try different cuisines in New Zealand, rather than eating Chinese food, which she would have had a lot of back in China.</p> <p>For E8, the candidate needed to also elaborate on why it is better to go for a walk by the beach instead of climbing the mountain for a view of Auckland.</p>				
3	E7	<p>The candidate demonstrated thorough understanding and communicated the implied meanings of the text by making a clear conclusion based on evidence from the text. The candidate clearly explained most of the problems Lanlan and Mary experienced on their day out at the cricket match. The candidate also clearly inferred how Lanlan should do things differently if she was to attend another sports game, based on clear understanding of what happened to them on this occasion.</p> <p>For E8, the candidate needed to demonstrate clear understanding of some details of the text, such as the time they left and when the match began, and that it was water rather than fizzy drink.</p> <p>The candidate made a few mistakes, including the length of the match. It was also not explained why they should take public transport instead of their own car.</p>
