1	M5	<p>The candidate demonstrated clear overall understanding of the text, despite some ambiguities and missing details. The candidate clearly explained two out of four problems Lanlan faced in the morning: the late bus and bad weather. They showed understanding that Lanlan did not speak good English. However, this was not explained as a part of her problem when she couldn't understand the teacher who tried to help her. The candidate demonstrated some clear understanding of the positive events Lanlan experienced after she joined the Chinese class.</p> <p>For M6, candidate needed to show understanding of some key details, such as why she thought the food was cheap, why she made special mention of lunchtime in the New Zealand school, as well as the other missing information regarding the problems Lanlan faced in the morning.</p>				
2	M5	<p>The candidate demonstrated clear overall understanding of the text, despite some ambiguities and missing details. On top of general understanding of the information provided on the two restaurants, the candidate showed some clear understanding of the activities they could do at Phoenix.</p> <p>The candidate showed less understanding of Golden House.</p> <p>For M6, the candidate needed to include details about Golden House, the mountain next to the restaurant, and how far the two places are from the shops Mary and Lanlan wanted to visit.</p>				
3	M5	<p>The candidate demonstrated clear overall understanding of the text, despite some ambiguities and missing details. Despite the misunderstanding of the carpark problem in the morning, candidate showed understanding of the expensive but bad tasting food, the bad weather, and the length of the match. Candidate also showed understanding between the lines in part (b) where relevant suggestions were made for Lanlan's next sports game based on understanding of the problems on the day.</p> <p>For M6, candidate needed to provide accurate information on the carparking problem, clarify the 'drink' Lanlan purchased, and explain that Lanlan watched a 12-hour long match that she did not understand.</p>
