1	A3	This answer reflects comprehension of some of the spoken text which is sufficient to supply some of the information but lacks fundamental details required to indicate a better level of understanding to fully explain Anna's plans for the day and justify her reasons.				
2	A3	Information in this answer is correct, and the candidate shows understanding of the general meaning of the spoken text, but it lacks accurate detail. For example Anna wants to work in Japan when she graduates.				
3	A4	This answer demonstrates understanding of the spoken texts and conveys the general meaning with a clear understanding that the places lending out umbrellas are in train stations. The lack of supporting detail about the reasons why the scheme is convenient - not requiring people to travel to far away places to return umbrellas, and no attempt to communicate implied meanings prevents it from reaching M5.				
4	A3	This answer provides evidence towards A3 rather than A4 because it demonstrates only some understanding of the spoken text and conveys some of the general meaning. This is particularly noticeable in response to the reasons Anna changes her mind about staying in a capsule hotel. There are no details about 'Sunshine,' being convenient as the word for vending machine is written in romaji which is condoned but indicates that the candidate knows which word is relevant but not what the word means.
