QUESTION ONE: ¡Tres razones para un año sabático! (Three reasons for a gap year)

Read Text A on page 2 of the resource booklet.

- (a) What are the advantages of taking a gap year before tertiary study?

The advantages of taking a gap year before tertiary study allows for students to prepare for things such as university when they do not feel prepared. It can help prepare you for the big change tertiary study and education can bring with new experiences and introspection.

Another advantage of a gap year before tertiary study can help better your abilities while reducing stress to better your life before entering a tertiary education system and studying for university. A gap year before university or any tertiary study provides everyone a chance to become independent, by volunteering in activities, learning about ~~new~~ cultures different from their own and exploring ~~countries~~ qualities.

- (b) Compare the advantages with someone who went directly from school to tertiary study.

The advantages weigh out better than going straight into university/tertiary education because with a gap year, you are able to do what you want in your life over the span of a year. You may not specifically know what you want to do with your life or not know who you are before entering tertiary studies at ~~edu~~ University, and a gap year provides that opportunity.

Taking a gap year provides you with ~~what~~ what you truly want to do in life such as a career path, which going straight to university from secondary school does not provide. As some may not know what they also want to study, it helps to take a gap year to discover self interests, find new passions and place time into what you want to do during tertiary studies, which someone without a gap year would not be able to accomplish going straight from secondary school to tertiary.

So not only does a gap year provide someone an opportunity to learn more about themselves before university, they are able to become independent and learn what they want to do with their lives while having a good time. Without a gap year, someone who went straight to tertiary studies wouldn't get these opportunities of personal exploration.

- (a) Why is it important for young people to participate in sport?

- (b) Explain how changes in sport will affect young people in the future.

changes in sport will affect young people in the future to become more strongly engaged with devices with exercise and devices combining together. With apps such as Zwift and many other platforms on social media, many more young people who are addicted to their devices may be interested in exercising and participating in sport to show off to family and friends how ~~far~~ many kilometers they ran, how many steps they took. Millennials and Gen Z will be affected in the future by more engaging to sport and exercise that is connected to technology, such as riding a bike with a screen to compete with friends, increasing competitiveness, within all young people. Changes to sport will help better their mental health and give them better sleep if they keep up exercising and playing sport to share with friends and family on the internet and social media. This makes it easier for the youth to connect with many without leaving their home but still exercising. In the future, many may no longer play sports in teams such as basketball or hockey as it can be done by the comfort of your home.

There was repetition of information in the second question and the candidate failed to cover other relevant information which would have enabled a more detailed and comprehensive answer.				
2	4	There was ambiguous understanding of the general meaning of the text with incorrect information regarding the use of data. The candidate attempted to translate the text without checking the overall meaning of the text.				
3	4	Another clear example of an A4 answer. The candidate was able to use the whole text to demonstrate general understanding. If the candidate had added some supporting detail, it would have warranted an M5.
