QUESTION ONE: 광고 (Advertisement)

Read Text A on page 2 of the resource booklet.

(a) Explain what the advertisement is promoting.

- (b) What types of tourists would these different options attract? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

It also ~~make~~ lets them to try for more tricks as they wouldn't be able to swim in a pool with dogs. This will attract tourists with more than 5 people as option B will become less costly compared to other when accommodation is also included. Also, tourists who plan on for barbecue or escaping hot weather of summer would decide going on for this promotion.

In Third, group of tourists who would like to go for a enjoyable ride would be attracted by this promotion. As option B offers lots of rides including ice skating and many ~~scenari~~^{scenarios} things to watch like parade and movie character shows, tourists like family who has young children would decide on this plan as food is included which means they don't have to go out ~~some~~ elsewhere to eat. Significantly people aged from 1 to 3 is free to enter which means a strong advantage to attract families who likely to have younger children and save cost.

- (b) Based on their opinions, who do you agree with more? Justify your answer using evidence from the text.

Based on their opinions, I agree more with ~~James~~ James that school rule needs to be presence to make safer school. As student like I do is still considered young who needs a close supervision by the school. The existence of school rule ~~definitely~~ definitely provides a right guideline for student to follow which ~~provide~~ will protect students from potential harm and saves time for student like James's opinion that school uniform lets him

not to think about what to wear in school. Also, school uniform makes school more neat. This is necessary as school is a place of learning and they need student solely focused in learning not decorating ~~themselves~~ themselves like jewelry. Banning them in school perfectly prevents any happening of conflict within students from trust or broken.

(b) Which job would be a good choice for James? Justify your answer using evidence from the text.

This is because James is a student and he cannot work for Job 2 as he need to work from morning in weekday when he would be at school. Job 1 is better than Job 2 as he only needs to work in the weekends and James likes animal and people ~~there~~ that matches a requirement of Job description but James plays football in Saturday morning so even if the time doesn't collide, he would be fined to ~~work~~ work for 7 hours for 2 strenuous days. Therefore Job 1 would still be unfit for James to work.
