


The two autworks depicting modernity and everyday life are A Sunday afternoom on the island of La Grand Lette by Surrat and 'La Gare Saintlazare' by Monef. These two autworks depict modernity and everyday life in the mid sourcestants nineteepth century French society. artwork

The first 11 will be discussing is "A Sunday afternoon on the island of La Grande Dette by Servert. This is a pointillism painting depicting people from all different walks of life enjoying the afternoon under the trees is and in the sub by the water. The first symbol in this artwork is the large amount of middle and upper class people at the park. This important subject matter in the artwork means that this place, this island, is apopular recreational spot for families to enjoy their weekend. There is a noticeable absence of Factory workers in thes this artwork, meaning that this party may be hours of the day when they are still at the factories working, while the middle and upper dass get to enjoy the day and outside. The second symbol that is seen in this artwork is the paint

application technique that Sevrat has used: Pointillism. This technique shows the meaning of modernity as it is was a new way of painting, a style that is drawn by Chevrault's colour meory. This shows the modernity of painting as it is not longer just about painting what you see, but about scientific advancements in colour theory in modern society.

These symbols from the Scurats artwork conveys meenings about modernity and everyday life through subject matter and painting style. The subject matter in this painting conveys the meaning that many middle and upper class citizens are able to go out during the day and enjoy their everyday lires, while factory workers and lower class attizens cannot afford this luxury. & Devrat choosing to use pointillium was inspired by cherrauts colow theory as if stated earlier. averyday life through subject matter and impressionist art style. The subject matter in this autwork convey the meaning that many middle class, duevage citizens use the frating trains often, wether traveling to and from work or just going on an outing. This shows meaning that society has advanced into a modern society, tothere and this train station is a place where many citnens spend their time, going about their everyday lives. The impressionistic style of this painting convey meanings about modernity because Monet is clearly rejecting perfect, geometric lick finished Neoclassical art style.
