Marker commentary

This portfolio was verified and placed in the middle of the Excellence grade range as it clearly fulfilled the criteria:

- Artist models have been introduced in the proposition, and the candidate is able to then interpret this with originality, showing a critical understanding of established practice.
- The candidate has shown an exceptionally strong starting point, which has been deeply researched as well as critically investigated and continues with fluency across the entire portfolio.
- Design conventions are evident across both panels. Illustration conventions are extended on Panel 1 through the development of different character poses and expressions to advance ideas. A thorough investigation of typography is clearly seen on Panel 1, this is appropriate to the purpose.
- Investigation has been framed fluently, which drives the development of ideas from the very beginning.
- Regeneration is seen on Panel 2 when typography, character, and setting are combined fluently to create compositional depth and drama.
- Mark making technique, bringing in woodblock aesthetic, is a fluent decision in combining design with another art field.
- Type, colour selection, and design aesthetic are all highly successful.
- This is an excellent example of character development and shows all the angles of facial expression and body motion.
