Marker commentary

This submission sits within the middle of the Achievement grade range for Level 6 of the New Zealand Curriculum. The submission contains an appropriate number of works, and each piece is finished, clearly demonstrating a sustained body of related artworks.

The coherence in the submission is evident through the adept use of line, colour, and subject matter, all contributing to a unified theme centred around landscape and identity. Notably, the submission weaves the candidate's Norwegian whakapapa into the New Zealand landscape, incorporating elements such as the flag and text to establish meaningful connections.

The application of art-making conventions is apparent, and the use of media aligns well with the expectations of Level 6 of the New Zealand Curriculum. The submission contains evidence of the candidate's ability to pictorially represent shape and form, giving a solid foundation to artistic techniques.

To advance, the submission would benefit from a more in-depth exploration of connected elements and landscape conventions. Additionally, a focus on the nuanced management of tonal modelling and the accurate recording of facial features would enhance individual artworks.

For Merit, continued emphasis on the development of connected elements, alongside refinement of landscape conventions, would be required.

Further exploration of the conceptual intention and connection between the meaning of text and the pictorial elements it is being placed with, or alongside, would be beneficial. Integrating text more seamlessly into visual elements, akin to the placement of the kōwhaiwhai pattern in the sky, would further elevate the submission.
