They identified some basic facts from the text about Xiaoming, Lili, and Lanlan, such as that Lili helps Xiaoming with his maths because he is not very good at it.</p> <p>To have achieved A4, the candidate needed to show understanding of key information to support their conclusion. This may have included the distance between Xiaoming's home and those of Lili and Lanlan, Lili's schedule on Saturday, and the common interests of Xiaoming and Lanlan.</p>
Two	M5	<p>The candidate demonstrated understanding by selecting and connecting relevant ideas and language to support their responses. They identified basic information about Hamilton and Moeraki and explained some differences between them.</p> <p>To have achieved M6, the candidate needed to support their conclusion with more detailed information in part (b) for both Hamilton and Moeraki.</p>
Three	A4	<p>The candidate demonstrated understanding of elements of the text to communicate general meaning / intent. They showed a general understanding of the requirements of the job as well as the information about Huahua and Tiantian, including their skills and when they would be available.</p> <p>To have moved into the Merit band, the candidate needed to respond to part (b) with more detailed and accurate information.</p>
