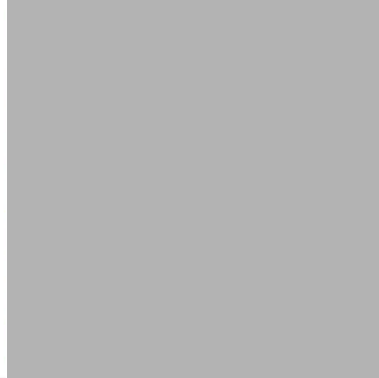

2	M5	Candidate has shown sound understanding of the passage. Greater detail about the purpose of the boat trip to Mokoia would have improved this answer.
3	M5	Sound understanding is shown in spite of the error with the time. A fuller answer to (b), referring to the passage, would have improved this answer.
