## Page 1 – Pilot Assessment

### QUESTION ONE: *Ko e fai'aho 'o Kiná (Kina's birthday)*

Read Text A on pages 2 and 3 of the resource booklet. Use it to answer Question One.

- (a) *Ko e hā e 'uhinga na'e 'ikai ke fie kátoanga'i faka-Tonga ai 'e Kiná hono fai'ahó? 'Omai ha 'uhinga ki ho'o talí mo ha fakamo'oni mei he fetohi'akí.*

Why didn't Kina want to celebrate her birthday in the Tongan way? Justify your answer with evidence from the text.

Kina didn't want to celebrate her birthday the Tongan way because she won't have anything good, she won't be happy and she won't like sitting at the front for 4 hours. 





What does Kina enjoy about the island of Felemea, and how do you know?

Kina enjoys the island of Felemea because she gets to meet her grandparents even when she can't really talk with them. This is mentioned at the very start of paragraph 2. She also received many gifts such as fua'i'akau 'o 'au ki he fala mo e ngatu. Their house is by the sea so they're always at the ocean all the time. When the tides are low, her and Leka go and look for sea stuffs. She mentions this all in paragraph 2 and 3.

- (b) *Na'e sai'ia nai 'a Leka 'i he ngaahi me'a na'e fai 'i motu 'i he fai'aho hono kaume'a ko Kiná, lolotonga 'ena 'i ai 'i he tutuku 'a e akó? 'Omai ha 'uhinga ki ho'o tall mo ha fakamo'oni mei he fetohi'aki.*

I think Leka wasn't really interested because before he said that he loves 'a e ngaahi me'a'ofa nge'esi fingota, fala and ngatu. Q	Grade score	Marker commentary
One	M5	This response provides sufficient evidence to reach Achievement, although the answers for both parts of the question were not of the same quality. The candidate describes how Kina did not like the traditional birthday celebration. But with how Leka felt when she was invited to go with Kina to the island, there was no elaboration on that part of the question or any respond to the second part of the question.
Two	A3	This evidence given is enough for Achievement. The candidate explains why Kina is disappointed after the planning meeting but the connection to Leka's plan is not clearly explained.
Three	M5	The candidate provides enough evidence for Merit. They explain how Leka's reasons for not enjoying the trip and how she was busy with her own thing. Her ideas were supported with evidence.
