Q	Grade score	Marker commentary
One	A4	The information is largely correct and demonstrates a general understanding of the spoken text; however, the situation with Alexa was misunderstood. The problem was not with Paul (the boyfriend), but with the jealous best friend. Also, Lily's friend did not hate her and, in fact, had apologised for being mean about her clothes behind her back
Two	A4	Some good information is given with the fact that "you don't have to wait until your next vacation to do a micro adventure", but the rest of the response lacks detail.
Three	A3	The candidate shows a good general understanding of how these young people view beauty and appearance – especially with the description of Anna's caring more about personality than good looks. A higher score may have been awarded if the candidate had offered new information from the text to back up their own opinions in their response to Part C.
