One	M6	The response demonstrates clear understanding and effectively communicates most of the meaning by using relevant supporting details from the text. However, it misses the opportunity to explore deeper interpretations.
Two	M6	The response shows clear understanding and communicates the main meaning with relevant supporting details. However, the candidate's attempt to address implied meanings lacks deeper development.
Three	M6	While the response demonstrates a good understanding of the text, it focuses on the benefits of travelling alone rather than capturing Xiaomei's nuanced change in mindset as her uncle tries to convince her.
