One	A4	Some relevant information was conveyed, although some of it lacked the detail required for Merit. There were also some inconsistencies, e.g. proceeds coming from viewers or everyone being excited to see familiar faces. Where the German word "Gesundheitssystem" was used, it is not clear that the meaning was understood.	
Two	A4	Some relevant information was conveyed. A higher grade could have been achieved with more specific details from the text,e.g. Steffen's views could have been described in more detail. There were also some inconsistencies, particularly in Part B, where the last paragraph is incorrect inference.	
Three	A4	A number of German words were used and understanding not demonstrated of these, e.g. "Stimmung" and "Adventskranz". Some relevant information was conveyed in Part A, although the candidate failed to make any convincing inferences in Part B, based on a misunderstanding of the text regarding music.
