### QUESTION ONE: 졸업식 (Graduation day)

Read Text A on page 2 of the resource booklet.

One	A4	The candidate wrote how the graduation was memorable for Moana, giving examples from the passage. However, the candidate did not explain or justify why or how the chosen information supports Moana's opinion. Some information that is necessary to reach Merit level was missing.
Two	A4	The candidate was able to relate Amiria's profile to university A and university B. They gave advantages and disadvantages. Most of the information was correct but the justification was slightly weak. A stronger justification was needed to achieve Merit.
Three	A4	The candidate answered most of the information that was given in the passage. However, they missed out why Ana was not convinced, and how Jihun gave solutions to convince Ana. Detailed justification was missing.
