QUESTION ONE: 졸업식 (Graduation day)

Read Text A on page 2 of the resource booklet.

Why was Moana's graduation ceremony memorable for her? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

B *I* U

First, it was very memorable as it was more of a ceremony than a graduation. The graduating students recieved flowers and gifts from their family as a celebration for graduating their school. She made a small mistake where she gave her graduating friend white flowers, which is only given in funerals to the passed person's families. So she couldn't give her friend the flowers and had to buy a different color flower. It could have been very disasterous, so it was very memorable for her.

Another big reason why it was so memorabe for her was how diffeerent it was to NZ graduation. In Moana's school, there are no official school graduations, and they only have prizegivings, which is just recieivng and giving prizes. Compared to this, Korean school's graduation was a lot more like a ceremony, as there were singers that came and had a concert for the graduated students. That singer was an alumni of that school, so they came and held a free concernt for the students. They even took photos with the students as an act of kindness.

She also thought the principal's speech was reall long and boring, which is very usual for every school. However, what was unusual was how other students were on their phones or listneing to music when the prinicple was talking, whihc is something very uncommon in NZ.

Another difference between korea and Nz's graduation is that in NZ, they make and gives out lollie lays much more than they give out flowers or gifts in celebration for thier friends or families. In graduation or prizegivings, families are also seen giving a haka to the student graduating.

These differences made Korean's graduation cemeony very memorable for her. She really really enjoyed the ceremony theme of korea's graduation, and really enjoyed the festive vibe of korean's graduations. It also looks like she really enjoyed how her favourite singer came to celebrate thier graduation. She wishes her school also has graduations as well.

QUESTION TWO: 대학정보 (University information)

(a) Which university would you recommend for Amiria? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

B *I* U

I recommend univeristy A.

Amiria wishes to have a exicing, fun and busy student life and wants to make many korean friends. This can be supported as the library in univeristy A is really big and has good facilities, so is very famous. THis means she can interact with many people and make lots of different friends. She can also make friends with people that is not from the univeristy as the library is very famous and so will have people from other univeristies, which can make her student life more fun. It is also next to a entertainment company, so she can befriend celebrities. This makes it possible for her to have many different friends, which will keep her entertained and busy.

Along with this, she isnt' good at cooking. This means she will most likely have to eat out, and there are many different restuarnages that are really good and cheap, and has nice owners. As there is a really big range she can choose from that is affordable, she won't have to worry about not being able to eat food and she won't get sick of eating the same food over and over. She also wants a busy life, so she could apply for a job at one of the restaurants, which pays more than other jobs and can get free food after her shift ends.

Another reason she should go to this university is because she wakes up late in the morning sometimes. She is a student, and it is extremely important that she makes it to her classes on time. As the school has a lot of subways or bus station, she can get to her classes in 2 minutes after getting off the transportations, which is really important if she doesn't want to be late to her classes. This also means there are lots of transportations availidable to take her out of school for her to explore the city, which is good to help her keep doing her hobbies of watching movies and exercising, as she can easily get to a gym or a movie theater using transportations after school.

Lastly, if she wants to make movies later as a job, it is important that she actually tries to make her own movie, which is supported in this university as there is a filming place that is free for students, and a room for editing movies. Building these experience is important in university as this is going to be extremely useful later on when applying to jobs, or if she mkaes a movvie and releases it and gets awards, it is enough to get recognition from other movie makers that can help her achieve her goals.

Overall, this univeristy can help her achieve her dreams, hobbies, and her lifestyle. Therefore I recommend this university.

(b) Why would you not recommend the other university for Amiria? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

B *I* U

I do not recommend university B for Amiria.

First, the university has a really big pool and gym, and a small theater for her and her friends to watch movies in. This is good to support Amiria's hobbies, but it is easily achievable even if the gym doesn't own the facilities for this as there are many facilities like this in korea.

Also, this campus is really big so it is easy for Amiria to get lost. Because she wakes up late in mornings, this could easily make her arrive late to her classes, which can have a really bad impact on her school profile. The campus aslo has a restarant, which isn't diverse in options but has healthy food. This is bad for Amiria and would not recommend as she cannot cook on her own so she will have to rely on this restaranat in the campus. As there aren't many options, Amiria could easily get sick of the food options they provide. In university A, there were many diverse options so they also most likely had helathy options, so it is recommended she goes to uni A istead.

There is a really beautiful cathedral that is sometimes seen in music videos or tv shows, but this is irrelavnt to Amiria as she wants to produce movies, not music videos or tv shows.

It is really good that there are alumnis of famous movie producers that watches movies and gives feedbacks, but I think it is better that Amiria gains more experience with making movies in Uni A with all the free facilities than it is with just recieveing feedback in Uni B. I assume that her major is in movie production, meaning she has chances to get feedback from her professors as well as her peers, and so as she is just starting with movie production i think it is more valuable that she gets more experience in making a lot of movies and getting feedback from her pefessors while having the lifestyle she wants, than it is for her to fixate on getting feedback to producers and not being able to make a lot of movies due to the llack of facilities, as well as her not having the busy lifestyle she wants.

Therefore, I do not recommend University B for Amiria, and I recommend University A for Amiria instead.

QUESTION THREE: 온라인 채팅 (Online chat)

Read Text C on pages 4 and 5 of the resource booklet.

Why would Ana be convinced to go on this trip? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

B I U

Ana is sad as she only has 3 days left in Korea before she goes back to New Zealand. She really wants to make special memories that can only be experienced in Korea before she leaves.

Jihun suggests that they go on a road trip to Jeonju tomorrow and says he has a friend that can drive, and it takes 4 hours to drive there. At first, Ana isn't keen in going as she gets headaches when she is in a car for too long, it is 4 hours to destination, and she doesn't have a lot of time to get ready for the trip.

Then Jihun suggests that they stop at gas stations (bigger and has more food) on the way. As there are lots of stations on the way, it wouldn't be hard on her headaches and wouldn't feel like a 4 hour long drive, instead an actual roadtrip. Ana is becoming more positive about this suggestion as she saw all the different foods in stations in a TV shows, and she has always wanted to go to stations as this is a very unique experience that is achievable in Korea.

After hearing this suggestion, Ana asks what the reasons for her to go to Jeonju is, which is a sign that she is leaning more to going to Jeonju. Hearing this, Jihun states that the best food in Korea is located in Jeonju, and it has more side dishes and is more diverse in options than it is in Seoul (capital of Korea), while Jeonju is really cheap.

There are also lots of traditional lessons Ana can take, such as traditional music lesson and learning how to play Arirang on any instrument, while wearing a renting hanbok (traditional clothes of Korea). Next to the lesson room is a beautiful temple, which is a really nice place to take photos from social media. 5 minutes of walking distance away from the temple is a traditional snack store.

Another lesson she can take is a cup making lesson. This is a nice monument to remember her trip to Jeonju, or even the entire trip to Korea, which she can take back to her home in NZ and remember her memories there. There are many different types of cups she can make, such as a beautiful flower or a cute animal cup. The cup takes 3 hours to be made, but around the lesson room are history museums and famous restaurants. She can even get a discount coupon if she writes a review of the cup making lessons on social media.

Ana was really sad that she only has 3 days left in Korea, and she wanted to have a special experience that can only be done in Korea. These lessons, restaurants, gas stations, and road trips are really special experiences that can only be done in Korea. Throughout the text, Ana's opinion about the trip became more positive, which can be seen as she started asking more questions to Jihun. I believe that she would definitely be convinced to go to Jeonju, as it is a special experience that she really wanted. Her headaches can be mitigated by the frequent station stops, and I would say it is very worth the short notice to go to Jeonju. She was really keen on the special foods in the stations, and she is very likely to accept the offer due to the Korean traditional experiences she can experience in Jeonju before she goes back home.
