QUESTION ONE: 졸업식 (Graduation day)

Read Text A on page 2 of the resource booklet.

Why was Moana's graduation ceremony memorable for her? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.

This experience would have been quite memorable to Moana and she will likely never forget to avoid white flowers as a gift on non funeral events.

Although the graduation ceremony was quite lengthy with the ~~principals~~ principal's speech being quite boring she was quite surprised that students were not paying attention to the

speech and instead playing on their phones or listening to music. This disrespectful behaviour demonstrated by the students in the ceremony would have left quite a memorable impression of the students at the school and the respect they have for the ~~principal~~ ~~principle~~ principal.

Moana's favourite idol showed up at the ceremony to perform, where afterwards they took photos with the students at the ceremony. Certain snacks and food are exclusively served at these rest stations as a form of tradition, and will be a valuable experience for Ana before she leaves Korea. Jeonju is a traditional Korean city which Jihun mentions that has "Korea's best food". Jeonju restaurants provide much better value service & larger variety and amount of side dishes. Ana can create additional special memories in Jeonju, going to get lessons on how to play Korean traditional instruments, experience wearing traditional

Korean Hanbok around Jeonju is free with lots of opportunities to snap amazing pics of your memories in Jeonju to upload online.

Another traditional experiences such as ~~watch~~ making traditional cups, and while visiting can go to restaurants or ~~the~~ the museum, can be also time efficient for Ana, being able to have all of these special experiences that can only be ~~be~~ had in Korea in a short amount of time with everything so closeby, given she only has 3 days left in Korea before she leaves back to NZ.

One	E7	The candidate showed thorough understanding of the passage, giving most of the justifications from the passage as well as some implied meanings. To get a solid Excellence, the candidate needed to fully justify answers and demonstrate understanding of most of the implied meanings from the text (e.g. Haka / Lolli lei and linking that to other ideas that were happening in the Korean graduation. The differences in the two graduations might have made it memorable for Moana).
Two	M6	The candidate was able to provide a strong answer in part (a) but was weaker in part (b). To get Excellence, the candidate needed to demonstrate understanding of implied meanings within the passage and explain the how and why (the thinking process).
Three	M6	The candidate showed thorough understanding of the passage. To get Excellence, the candidate needed to show more of their thinking process (implied meanings) across the passage to show how Ana would be convinced to go on the trip. Also, some justification details (e.g. making cup) were weak.
