Instead of going as planned, the trip is cancelled because of heavy rain and strong winds are expected during the scheduled time.	
Two	E7	The candidate showed a thorough understanding of the text and indicated the intent of the speaker through their responses. The candidate answered the question by explaining that Xiaoming shares details about a Chinese New Year celebration happening at Liang Liang's house with friends. Xiaoming invites Jing Jing to join since she has no plans, advises her to wear red, and reassures her that food and drinks are already prepared. He also provides directions on how to get there.	
Three	M5	The candidate selected relevant evidence from the text to demonstrate a connected understanding. Both parts (a) and (b) needed more evidence from the text to show what James had to consider and why he was happy about his purchases.
