One	A4	The candidate demonstrated some understanding of the text and communicated the general meaning. They have described who Miki is and some facts about the town.
Two	A4	The candidate has answered the question correctly, demonstrating the general meaning of the text. The overall intent is clear, but answers are brief and lack detail. A more detailed response would include information such as wanting to get better at cooking and referring to the days and times.
Three	A3	The candidate demonstrated a basic understanding of text. However, including why Takeshi has bought the souvenirs, how the conversation helped him, and what he will doing with his friends tomorrow, would have made the response more detailed.
