Q	Grade score	Marker commentary
One	A3	This response shows that the candidate understands the Spanish text by recognising key points. For example, in part (a), they correctly identify that Maddie is looking for a fun and nice Hispanic friend. They also demonstrate understanding of what the main ideas are in parts (b) and (c). However, they don't fully connect details across the text. For example, they indicate that Pablo finds the beach boring, but they don't link this to the fact that Maddie enjoys swimming in the sea. This makes it seem like a random fact rather than a clear example of their different interests.
Two	A3	The response mostly shows a general understanding of the text rather than specific details. Because of this, the response to Question Two is slightly weaker compared to Questions One and Three. The candidate recognises important words like "cultura", "familia", and "historia" to explain similarities. When talking about differences, they give some specific details, like how a marae is used for family events such as weddings and funerals, while the Santa Maria del Mar is used for occasions such as Christmas. They also note that the marae is used for more activities, like eating together. These details help show that they understand the text.
Three	A3	The candidate shows they understand the Spanish text by identifying key information and opinions without major mistakes. They correctly understand the purpose of the text and describe Víctor's personality and interests. They also choose Jardín as the better destination with a good reason and only a few small errors. To reach a higher grade, the candidate would need to include more details and make stronger connections between different parts of the text.
