One	M5	The candidate understood the gist of the text and was able to add some detail beyond that. For example, beyond recognising a positive experience in the fruit shop, detail was added on where the bananas came from, that the seller was nice, that the bananas were fresh, and that the price was lowered. There were some inconsistencies in information.
Two	M5	The candidate understood the gist of the text and was able to add some detail beyond that. For example, beyond identifying what Tomatina is about, the candidate identifies when it is held, that it is cheap, and some negative aspects of the festival. There were some inconsistencies in information. The response provides some connection of ideas in part (c), but lacks the level of detail required for M6.
Three	M6	The candidate has provided well rounded answers with good detail to confirm their responses. Part (c) shows good connecting of information, such as the fact that Camila could use her languages in a flight attendant job. The candidate draws conclusions, however lacks some detail and coherence required for E7.
