The candidate understands that grandmother was in hospital and has a garden with sweet pineapples and has looked at how she won't be able to return to her old activities.
	To achieve a merit, the candidate needed to link their part (b) answer to support their response in part (a) about Grandmother doing well.	
Three	А3	The response shows an understanding of Tangata's day and how his parents were treating him and demonstrates some understanding of how his attitude changed throughout the day.
		To secure a high achievement, the candidate needed to provide more detail about what happened in the shop and why meeting his friends made the knots in his stomach subside because of his nerves about school.
