Standard specific comments	Candidates may answer in English, Te Reo Maori and/or Korean, however they need to understand that by providing responses that include Korean language, they may not demonstrate evidence of their understanding of the text. Candidates must understand that all the evidence provided in their responses must be re-phrased in their own words to show clear and thorough understanding.
