Te Wāhanga 1: He Tirohanga Whānui

Ka tutuki te aromatawai nei i ngā hiahia o te paerewa paetae. Ka āhei ngā ākonga ki te whakaatu atu i ō rātou pūkenga pānui ki tēnei whakamātautau ki te taumata kua whakaritea.

Te Wāhanga 2: He kōrero mō te Paerewa

91652: Te ingoa o te paerewa paetae: Pānui kia mōhio ki te reo Māori o te ao whānui

Te Aromatawai ā-Waho:

Ka pānuitia e ngā ākonga ngā reta e rua. Ko te tuatahi te reta a te mokopuna e pātai atu ana ki tōna kuia mō te panonitanga o tētahi/ētahi o ngā tikanga i roto i ngā tau. Ko te tuarua, ko te urupare a te kuia ki tāna mokopuna. Ko tā te ākonga mahi he whakautu i ngā pātai i runga anō i tāna i pānui ai.

Te Tirohanga:

Ko ngā ākonga i eke ki te Paetae, i whakaatu i ngā pūkenga ki te tuhituhi i ā rātou whakautu ki ngā pātai i roto i ō rātou ake kupu, me te whai anga o te whakautu. Ko ngā ākonga i āhei ki te tūhono i ngā whakaaro me ngā whakamārama whai kiko, me te whakauru tauira mai i te tuhinga, i eke ki te Kaiaka, Kairangi rānei. Ko ngā ākonga i whakaatu i te āheinga ki te whakawhānui ake i ngā kōrero o te tuhinga, me te whakauru i ō rātou ake whakaaro, tirohanga, manako hoki ki te whakautu, i tohu i te māramatanga kairangi ki te tuhinga.

Me āta pānui i ngā pātai, me te karo i te tāruarua kōrero kāore e hāngai pū ana ki te whakautu (i kitea nuitia tēnei i roto i ngā whakautu i whakamāori i te katoa o te tuhinga). Me āta mahara

hoki ngā ākonga ki te whakaputa i ngā kōrero mā ō rātou ake kupu (ehara te panoni i te kupu kotahi, torutoru rānei o te rerenga kōrero mai i te tuinga i te tuhituhi mā ōna ake kupu e ai ki ngā tohutohu; he āhuetanga tēnei i kitea nuitia i roto i ngā mahi a te hunga i tuhituhi ki te reo Māori), ā, me pūmau tonu ki te whakaputa i ngā ihirangi i roto i ō rātou ake kupu, e ai ki te whakahau.

Pūrongo Paerewa Paetae:

Ko ngā Ākonga i eke ki te **Paetae** i te paerewa paetae nei:

Ko te nuinga o ngā huinga whakautu kua eke ki te tapeke e 8, e rua, neke atu rānei ngā whakautu Paetae kei roto, ā, ko te nuinga o ngā ākonga i ngana ki te whakautu i ngā pātai e toru. E tohu ana tēnei ko te 8 te pae o raro mō te Paetae.

Ko ngā Ākonga i eke ki te **Kaiaka** i te paerewa paetae nei:

Ko te nuinga o ngā huinga whakautu kua eke ki te tapeke e 13, e rua ngā whakautu Kaiaka, kotahi te whakautu Paetae kei roto. Ko te nuinga o ngā ākonga i uru ki tēnei pae kaute i whakautu tika i ngā pātai e toru, engari i hapa ngā taipitopito o tētahi. Ko te nuinga o ngā huinga whakautu e 18 te tapeke, he whakautu Kaiaka ngā mea e toru.

Ko ngā Ākonga i eke ki te **Kairangi** i te paerewa paetae nei:

Ko te nuinga o ngā huinga whakautu i tēnei pae, i te pito o raro arā i te 19, e rua ngā whakautu Kairangi me te whakautu Kaiaka kotahi, ko tētahi whakautu Kairangi rānei me ngā whakautu Kaiaka e rua (he Kaiaka kaha te nuinga).

Ko ngā Ākonga **Kāore i whiwhi** i te paerewa paetae nei:

He onge te wā i whakautua ai e ngā ākonga o tēnei pae ngā pātai e toru, tērā rānei he whakautu Paetae kotahi, ā, e rua ngā whakautu Kāore i Whiwhi, i te mea kāore i rawaka ngā taunakitanga i tukuna.

Section 1: Commentary

Candidates who achieved showed an ability to write their responses to the questions in their own words and were structured in their response. Candidates who were able to link ideas together with detailed justifications and included examples from the text achieved at a merit or excellence level. Candidates who showed an ability to extend beyond what was presented in the text and incorporate their own ideas, thoughts and opinions into their response indicated an excellent understanding of the text.

Section 2: Report on Achievement Standard

91652: Title of standard: Pānui kia mōhio ki te reo Māori o te ao whānui

Candidates are encouraged to read the questions carefully and avoid repeating information that does not directly answer it (mostly found in answers that were directly translating the whole text). Candidates are also to be mindful of paraphrasing the text (changing one or a few words in a sentence from the text is not writing it in one’s own words as required in the instructions, which seems to be most frequently seen in those writing in te reo Māori) and must genuinely express the content in their own words as required. Paraphrasing is a learnt skill and a focus in preparing candidates for this achievement standard.

The majority of the combination of answers that have a combined total of 8 include at least two achieved answers and most students have attempted to answer all three questions. This indicates that 8 should be the lower boundary for an Achieved.

Report on Achievement Standard:

Ākonga who were awarded **Achievement with Excellence** commonly:

Presented a combination of answers that have a combined total of 13 include at least two merit answers and one achieved answer. Most students who achieved within this cut score range successfully answered all three questions, with one being slightly less detailed. The majority of the combination of answers that have a total of 18 are usually three merit answers.

Ākonga who were awarded **Achievement with Merit** commonly:

Presented a combination of answers in this range at the lower end of 19 have either two excellence answers and one merit answer, or one excellence answer and two (usually high) merit answers.

Ākonga who were awarded **Achievement** commonly:

Rarely answered all three questions or may have one achieved answer and two not achieved answers usually by not providing enough evidence.
