The candidate may have used more features of the language to support their writing.</p>	<p>The candidate has:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>produced an in-depth piece of writing in te reo Māori on the chosen topic</li> <li>presented and expanded further on their own ideas, opinions, and / or perspectives on the topic</li> <li>enhanced their writing with supporting evidence that purposefully reinforces their thinking</li> <li>shown a depth of thought and meaning relating to the topic</li> <li>provided a piece of writing that is easily understood</li> <li>produced a piece of writing that is well-structured and coherent, and follows a logical sequence of thought</li> <li>demonstrated a comprehensive understanding of writing conventions</li> <li>consistently utilised a wide range of appropriate grammar and language features in te reo Māori.</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> For KR8, the writing has minimal errors, is well-detailed, and uses higher-level grammar, structures, and other features of the language.</p>
