Media Studies: Demonstrate understanding of an aspect of a media genre (91251)

<p><i>Demonstrate understanding</i> involves identifying a genre and describing an aspect of a specific media genre using detailed supporting evidence from a range of media texts within the genre, and / or other sources.</p> <p>Examples of genres include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • teenage magazines (print) • western movies (film) • documentaries (film or television) • soaps (television) • breakfast shows (radio) • social networking sites (internet). 	<p><i>Demonstrate in-depth understanding</i> involves giving reasoned explanations of an aspect of a specific media genre.</p> <p>A <i>reasoned explanation</i> involves a logical argument of how and / or why the aspect has an impact on the media genre, by responding to the chosen statement, using specific supporting evidence from a range of media texts within the genre, and secondary sources.</p> <p><i>Note: The candidate does not need to include evidence of additional texts to achieve Merit if the explanation is integrated within the description.</i></p> <p>The explanation could cover such things as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • how and / or why changes (e.g. development of sub-genre, changes in the use of features) in the media genre have occurred • how and / or why audience expectations and / or response to the media genre exist, or have developed • how and / or why commercial considerations influence the media genre. 	<p><i>Demonstrate critical understanding</i> involves examining the likely implications of an aspect of a specific media genre and drawing conclusions based on the supporting evidence from a range of media texts within the genre, and relevant secondary sources.</p> <p>The examination can be stated as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a broad generalisation, providing it is drawing a conclusion about an earlier explanation that is well supported by detail and evidence • a detailed comparison with other genres or media forms, with new evidence • a conclusion that shows insight or understanding of the complexities within the aspect, with detail and evidence.

(The implication(s) could be about such things as the effect of the aspect on the genre itself, media audiences, other media, or other issues relevant to the genre, aspect, and the statement chosen.)</p> <p>Focuses on the genre, using some carefully selected evidence from primary and secondary sources, such as articles, media criticism, or media theory, to support the discussion.</p> <p>Responds to the chosen statement throughout most of the essay, with some nuance.</p>	<p>Examines in detail the implication(s) of the aspect for the media genre and draws conclusions.</p> <p>Focuses on the genre, using carefully selected evidence from primary and secondary sources, such as articles, media criticism, or media theory, to support the discussion.</p> <p>Shows an awareness of the complexities of the aspect for the media genre, media producers, or the audience.</p> <p>Responds to the chosen statement throughout the essay, with nuance.</p>
