1 purpose

This certificate is a national certificate for people working in the wool scouring industry. The qualification is a means of recognising advanced skills and knowledge that people working in wool scouring have achieved. People who have achieved this qualification will have the skills and knowledge necessary to operate a wool scour and the related processes.

A number of the core skills unit standards in this qualification are also included in the National Certificate in Wool Scouring (Early Stage Wool Processing) (Level 4). The National Certificate in Wool Scouring (Operations) (Level 2) is an intermediate step towards this qualification but is not a prerequisite.

2 regulations for the qualification

2.1 entry information for programmes of education and training assessed against the unit standards in the qualification

Open. There are no prerequisite requirements for entry to the qualification. However, because of the need for work place training in the majority of the unit standards, it is recommended that only persons employed in a wool scour enrol on a programme leading to this qualification.

It is also recommended that entrants to training leading to this qualification have achieved the National Certificate in Wool Scouring (Operations) (Level 2) which includes initial knowledge of wool scouring process and technology, and skills in selected activities carried out in a wool scour.

2.2 recognition of prior learning

Prior learning will be recognised at both unit standard and qualification level.
