Purpose

This qualification is for people who are working at a supervisory level in a compliance and regulatory control function in the animal control industry. They may be either working as employees of local government or as contractors to local government. People holding this qualification will be competent in the compliance and regulatory control and communication skills required to complete and action animal control investigation functions.

The qualification has an optional strand for Animal Control Officers working in animal shelters, which covers the skills and knowledge required to undertake work in an animal shelter dealing with behavioural problems, emergency euthanasia, and environmental hygiene. It also covers the skills and knowledge required to be able to receive, re-home, release, or dispose of homeless animals.
