Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu | Assessment information and grade criteria

Assessment specifications:

Assessment must be in a manufacturing environment, and meet required production rates, job specifications, workplace health and safety requirements and workplace procedures.

A manufacturing environment refers to a site where flooring cassettes are constructed using repeated and partially mechanised processes.

Assessment evidence for this standard must reflect industry standards and follow workplace procedures. Industry standards refer to verbal and written information covering company policy, standard operating procedures and processes and job-specific instructions. Working to industry standards must be confirmed by a person with current expertise in flooring cassette manufacture.

Detail drawings show 2D image of flooring cassette and blow out details with dimensions, connections, fixing type and methods.

Instructions will list components, hardware and fixing and instructions for assembly and sequencing of assembly.

Detail drawings and instructions are used as a reference for quality control.
