**Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu | Assessment information and grade criteria***Assessment specifications:*

Candidates must be capable of consistently interpreting information in plans and documentation for specific construction tasks.

Assessment must include evidence for specific construction tasks within a wider construction work programme or a small construction job.

*Dimensions* refer to all measurements related to specific construction programme tasks and may include site layout.

*Documentation* refers to specifications, manufacturer's instructions, architectural and engineering drawings, and other detailed information required to complete the planned tasks.
