Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu | Assessment information and grade criteria

Assessment specifications:

Candidates must be able to consistently use and maintenance a range of equipment and tools required to perform familiar tasks in a construction environment.

Candidates must be capable of performing skills:

- in a safe manner
- to current industry, regulatory, and commercial standards.

A *construction environment* is any environment where construction, modification, or maintenance of buildings, structures, or infrastructure assets takes place.

Equipment refers to the range of non-mechanical equipment or mechanical equipment typically required for construction tasks.

Maintain refers to routine tasks performed to keep tools and equipment in working order. It does not include tasks requiring the services of a specialist engineer or service technician.

Tools refer to the range of hand and power tools typically required for familiar construction tasks.
