	c. Any minor surface defects are repaired in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.		
	d. Size coating or pigmented sealer is applied to the substrate surface.		
2. Apply wallcoverings.	Standard wallcoverings are applied to work area ensuring the surface is even, seams are butted, paper is plumb, and pattern is free of defects.		
	b. Trimming around fittings are completed with minimal impact on surroundings.		
	c. Unused materials are sealed and stored in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.		

# **Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu** | Assessment information and grade criteria Assessment specifications:

The candidate must be capable of preparing application area and materials and applying standard wallcoverings to flat walls in accordance with worksite requirements.

Wallcoverings may include lining paper, paper-backed, non-woven backed, and pattern matched.

Evidence is required of application on any two of the substrate surfaces:

- set plaster
- fibrous plaster
- plaster board.

To achieve this standard the candidate must be capable of consistently:

- performing the skill in a safe manner
- performing the skill to the required industry standard
- performing the skill in an environmentally sustainable manner
- repeating the skill on demand.
