#### Ihirangi waitohu | Indicative content

- Anatomy of the face, including recognition of common facial shapes, and eye shapes.
- Structure and functions of the skin of the face with reference to basic anatomy and physiology.
- Common skin types and conditions and when these need to be referred to a specialist for treatment.
- Effective questioning and listening techniques to consult with and advise clients.
- Makeup colour and design principles
- Makeup services and treatments for different occasions, (e.g., daytime, evening, bridal, school formal, photography), and client types (such as male, mature, and globally diverse clients with considerations for skin tone and type).
- Makeup product types and uses including, concealer, contour, foundation, powder, blusher, eye cosmetics (eye shadow, eye liner, mascara), lip cosmetics (lipstick, lip liner, lip gloss).
- Maintaining client records.
- Personal presentation and hygiene.
- Ethics and behavioural standards as required by legislation and codes of practice.
