	b. Apply makeup styles appropriate to the client's needs and services.
	c. Conduct service professionally to an industry standard, including personal presentation and hygiene.
3. Complete service.	a. Provide follow-up services for client, including skincare routines, makeup techniques and product usage to maintain and enhance skin.
	b. Sanitise tools and equipment to an industry standard.

Assessment specifications:

The assessment must take place in a realistic practical setting, such as a salon, retail workplace, or other simulated setting.

- Cleaning and/or sanitising tools, equipment, and work areas to a standard that is consistent with relevant legislation and codes of practice.
- Personal presentation and hygiene.
- Ethics and behavioural standards as required by legislation and codes of practice.
