<b>Whāinga   Purpose</b>	<p>This skill standard is for people intending to gain an introduction to basic skills relevant to the building, construction, and allied trades sectors.</p> <p>This skill standard recognises the skills to implement safety practices during a project or related tasks for building, construction, and allied trades.</p> <p>This skill standard aligns with the New Zealand Certificate in Building, Construction, and Allied Trades Skills (Level 1) [Ref: 3843].</p>

### Hua o te ako me Paearu aromatawai | Learning outcomes and assessment criteria

Hua o te ako   Learning outcomes	Paearu aromatawai   Assessment criteria
1. Use safety practices for a BCATS project or related tasks.	a. Hazards associated with the project, and appropriate control measures, are identified.
	b. Personal protective equipment required for the project is selected and used appropriately according to manufacturer's instructions.
	c. Safety controls are used when project tasks are carried out with regard for own safety and the safety of others.
	d. Follow-up procedures are completed to maintain a tidy work area and to care for tools, plant, and equipment used for the project.

### Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu | Assessment information and grade criteria

#### Assessment specifications:

Candidates must demonstrate competence for this skill standard while undertaking a project or related tasks. Projects or related tasks at this level should demonstrate basic processes and techniques, using a limited range of tools, focusing on following instructions and plans to achieve the project requirements.

Assessment must take place across the duration of the project.

Follow-up procedures may include cleaning and safe storage of tools, plant, and equipment, and leaving the work area tidy.
