Candidates must complete each of the project tasks required to construct a cupboard with a drawer. See the BCATS Programme Guidance document for a list of example projects that show an appropriate level of complexity.

It is expected that:

- project documentation for the cupboard with a drawer is provided to candidates.
- minor blemishes in the project do not affect functionality.

Finish refers to the documented final treatment of the project and may include smooth edges and corners, sanding, application of stains, coatings or coverings.

- Appropriate materials for cupboards.
- Basic terminology and calculations to help with the cutting list.
- Tools required to construct the cupboard and drawer.
- Setting up and maintaining a safe worksite.
- Importance of straight lines and cutting lengths, and how they are achieved.
- Correct joinery techniques for timber furniture.
- Finishing processes.
- Reflection on the success or failure of the project.
- Quality control checks.
