Assessment specifications:

Candidates must complete each of the project tasks for a Level 2 BCATS project. Where the project is completed as a group, candidates much demonstrate competence for each of the project requirements.

A project suitable for this skill standard:

- can be prescribed, using a range of techniques and tools to achieve the project outcome,
- is not already named as a project in other Level 2 assessment standards in the *Building, Construction, and Allied Trades Skills* domain.
- is not to be awarded for projects undertaken for achievement standards.

It is expected that:

- project documentation for the project is provided to candidates.
- minor blemishes in the project do not affect functionality.

*Finish* refers to the documented final treatment to create the desired surface finish of the project and may include smooth edges and corners, sanding, application of stains, coatings or coverings.
