Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu | Assessment information and grade criteria**Assessment specifications:**

To achieve this standard the candidate must be capable of identifying and carrying out installation tasks for interior joinery doors and cabinetry units under limited supervision to industry standards.

Industry standards must reflect industry best practice, workplace procedures, and be within acceptable tolerances as defined in New Zealand codes, standards and regulations.

Plans and specifications can include working drawings, plan specifications, manufacturer specifications, installation instructions and work, demolition and project plans.

Under limited supervision refers to candidates carrying out the requirements of this skill standard with basic guidance and indirect supervision from a suitably skilled tradesperson. They are expected to source some information independently from plans, specifications, or relevant New Zealand Standards.

This standard must be assessed in the workplace.

Evidence for this standard must be demonstrated:

- to current and relevant Legislation, Standards, and Codes (including safety),
- in an environmentally sustainable manner,
- within an acceptable timeframe,
- with acceptable behaviours.

Types and properties of interior doors

- Types of doors: solid core, double, hollow core (rail and honeycomb), sliding, cavity slider, aluminium doors, fire-rated doors, sound-control doors.
- Properties of doors: standard sizes, durability, finishes, sound-control ratings.

Preparing for installation of interior doors

- Confirm delivery times and site access.
- Store and protect materials appropriately on-site.
- Select the correct door for the opening.
- Determine the opening direction.
- Check for correct fixing height and framing requirements.
- Accounting for floor coverings during installation planning.

Installation requirements for interior doors

- Sequence and techniques.
- Use packers for levelling and plumbing.
- Confirm framing requirements, especially for cavity sliders.
- Follow the prescribed installation sequence to ensure alignment and functionality.

Installation requirements for cabinets

- Types of cabinets: bathroom cabinets, wardrobes, screens, kitchen cabinets.
- Perform pre-installation checks (e.g. underlying framing, service locations).
- Determine starting heights and levels.
- Following the correct installation sequence.
- Fix and level cabinets.
- Install toe kicks, panels and benchtops.
- Handle and protect materials during installation.
